To apply, the applicant must provide a letter of intent summarizing academic history, extracurricular & community activities, scholarly achievement and academic & career goals. A certified copy of the applicants high school transcript must accompany the application. Applications will be due to your unit director, or member of the board no later than March 31st.

The board will review applications during the April board meeting and the winner will be announced in April's newsletter where a certificate and a check will be awarded to the winner.

DEED RESTRICTION OF THE MONTH

It has been requested that this publication starts listing more information regarding deed restrictions. So to fulfill that request, we will describe a deed restriction in each issue. Please remember that some restrictions do not effect every unit. For more on deed restrictions see the website.

For this month we will take up the sign issue.

"No sign of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot except for one professionally lettered sign not more than 4 feet square in size advertising the property for sale or rent, and except for signs used by a builder to advertise the property during the construction and sales period".

Although not all units are identical, the deed restrictions are for EVERYONE living in Oakleaf Village.

So regardless of how much you believe in a candidate, subject, law or other matter please do not post signs about it.


