

# **DRY WEATHER**



March and April are historically dry months in Florida. It's a good idea to check your irrigation before you really need it.

The timer might be working but the coverage may not be as it should be. Sprinkler heads get clogged very easily so make sure they are working properly if you want a healthy lawn and to achieve the look you are after. Also check your watering days. We are still under water restrictions for lawn irrigation. If you're not sure what days to water, check the city's web site to confirm.

# **ALLIGATOR MATING SEASON**

"Spring has Sprung" in Florida (earlier than normal) and along with it is alligator mating and nesting season. From now until late June is the time of year when cold blooded alligators warm up and start to move from one body of water to another looking for a mate. The ponds in Oakleaf Village are connected through an underground storm water drainage system. This makes it easy for them to move around.

People that live near any body of water are warned to be aware. Do not walk your pet or let small children play close to the ponds or lakes. There have been residents of Oakleaf observed letting their dogs play in ponds. Just because you haven't seen an alligator does not mean there aren't any there. If you value you pets, keep them away from the water.

Keep in mind that it is against the law to feed or molest an alligator. Feeding them only makes them more dangerous. If you should see one just keep your distance
