So if you are taking walks around the neighborhood please wear bright clothing, place reflective tape on your clothes, or carry a light.

SECURITY PATROL **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

The OVHA Security Patrol is comprised of a group of your friends and neighbors who volunteer their time to help keep us safe. The schedule comes out every month. They drive around the neighborhood looking for something unusual. People breaking in cars for example. Then they call law enforcement and report the issue. They do not get out of the car or give chase, that's not what they are there for. Just having someone driving by with security patrol signs on the car is a detourant. There is no set schedule for the time to do the drive by so it can't be timed by thieves or vandals. We need more volunteers to do this. Right now, each member is scheduled for two consecutive days per month. Each drive by takes between 30 and 45 minutes once a day so 1 to 1 1/2 hours per month is all that is needed. 
